Staffing

- Interviewed last night for Grade 5 position, 75 applicants, short listed to 5. Successful candidate is Jaymi Roth – has been teaching Grade 10 at CHHS, has a vast background including business and fine arts, badminton and basketball.
- Posting a number of positions soon, including Grade 2,3,4,6,7 and sift
- New Vice Principal – Warren Buckler, currently councillor at MHHS and principal of Summer school, a great resource for our junior high kids as they prepare for high school
- Re-assigning staff within the school, still a moving puzzle so won't be shared at this point. Will know by end of June when timetable and teacher assignments come out
- Collaborative Periods for Teachers
 - Learning sprints
 - Bringing in supports and resources for teachers

Monthly Assemblies for 1-3 and 4-6 next year
