- Lack of fundraising from this year and previous years has resulted in no funding for field trips for future years. It will be up to the families to provide funding for their kids to go on field trips.

Co-teaching proposal and feedback

There are 850 students projected for next year (836 currently registered) however, it
has been determined that co-teaching will not take place as there are many conflicts
such as sensory issues, relationships with the teacher etc. We are instead going to look
into community classrooms

Budget plans for next year

- We will not need to budget for Spring Royale (Not organizing one), Breakfast program will be in our budget (\$7500 approx. TBD) Literacy and Project Commons will not need to be funded from parent council. Uniforms will not be in the budget.
- There is the possibility of a trauma team that could be supported by parent council. They would potentially visit classes/assemblies to help out students with mental health issues.

Principal Report

- We will not be taking any students from out of our boundary. The Band and Music room will be combined together to open another room. The project commons could potentially be a classroom as well.
- Concrete blocks have been put in to surround the mud pits so it's a little less messy outside for the kids.
- An e-mail is being sent out to form a Grade 9 farewell committee. The grade 9 farewell is tentatively booked for June 25th, the caterers have been booked.
- 181 surveys have been filled out so far, the survey will be open until April 22nd.
- Vice Principal Lisa Lindsay was in an unfortunate accident and will be off temporarily.
 Our thoughts are with her at this time.
- The winners of the read-a-thon will be doing the morning announcements with Mr. K during read-a-thon. The kids are very excited for this!
- The Junior high soccer team will start the week of April 29th. We have joined with Alexandra Middle School as there was only one student for their school who wished to participate.
- The Junior high will receive new lockers in July, the school district will be paying for the \$30,000 cost.
